Subject: NCUA Phishing Scam

There is a new version of a NCUA phishing scam circulating... it is a phishing scam that warns you about phishing. The first paragraph in the phishing email is identical to NCUAs Internet/E-mail Fraud Alert notice on their website. The phishing email warns about the false attempts to obtain credit card account number and PIN, and then proceeds to have you complete a form that includes a host of personal information and requests that you sign the form.

The content of the phishing email:

Dear NCUA account holder,

Recently, there have been multiple e-mail fraud attempts, known as "Phishing", that were initiated via e-mail sent to both the general public and to some credit union members that appeared to be from NCUA. This false e-mail asked for the recipient to click on a link to verify their bank account registration. If the recipient proceeded to do so, the link directed them to a false website and asked for their credit card account number and PIN, along with other personal information. At NCUA the highest interest to our customers is the safekeeping of confidential information you have entrusted to us and using it in a secure manner. A fundamental element of safeguarding your confidential information is to provide protection against unauthorized access or use of this information.

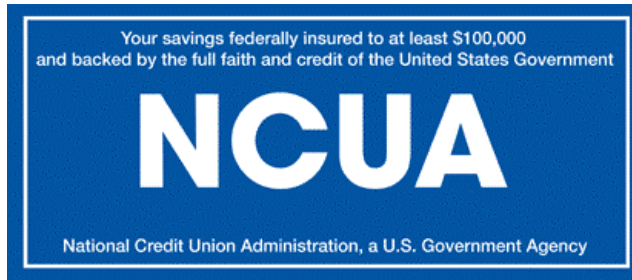

As soon as our database will be updated we will contact you for further information's and to make some important announcements so please complete the form attached to this mail with no delay.
